We are working with more than 200 women members of the Women's Associations of the department of Chalatenango in organic production processes to guarantee an improvement in the economy and the quality of life of women and their families. As a result of these processes, women have trained in sustainable agriculture with a focus on agroecologist.

With the campaign Women Sowing Seeds of Hope, we seek to continue supporting organized women in Chalatenango in the different processes they carry out from their communities. To contribute to the development of family sustainability based on the production that guarantees healthy and sustainable food, also the care of water, land, and native seeds.
